Dual citizens and permanent residents should *not* apply as an international applicant.

In addition to the required application materials outlined on TCNJ's Admissions site, international students must also submit:

- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) Scores are required if English is not your native language. A minimum score of 80 (internet-based exam) or 550 (paper-based exam) is recommended for the TOEFL; a score of 7 or higher is recommended for the IELTS. If these minimum requirements are not met, applicants may qualify for *conditional admission* to the institution if eligible for the College's Institute for English as a Second Language and American Studies: <http://esl.pages.tcnj.edu/>.
- Original or certified copy of all transcripts: Foreign transcripts may need to be translated and/or evaluated by one of the following agencies before the application can be reviewed: <http://admissions.pages.tcnj.edu/files/2011/06/ListofUnitedStatesAgencies.pdf>.
